
Dear Michael Landgraf:

It is hard to believe that two years have already passed since your donation of a light and sound system to our department. As you are aware, emphasis for using the system is with clients who are in need of stress reduction and relaxation. But light and sound technology is not for everyone. Many of our clients have not been able to utilize the system because they are either light sensitive or suffer from seizure activity.

We find the Photosonix 515 more adaptable to our needs. With the capability of program sessions being played through stereo speakers, we can incorporate the 515 into our treatment sessions. Whether one-on-one or in a group situation, the 515 has been a benefit to a number of our clients. And with budget constraints being what they are, the 515 system is a much more realistic instrument than previous light and sound/sound only units. We also enjoy it's ease of operation and how little time is necessary for preparation.
